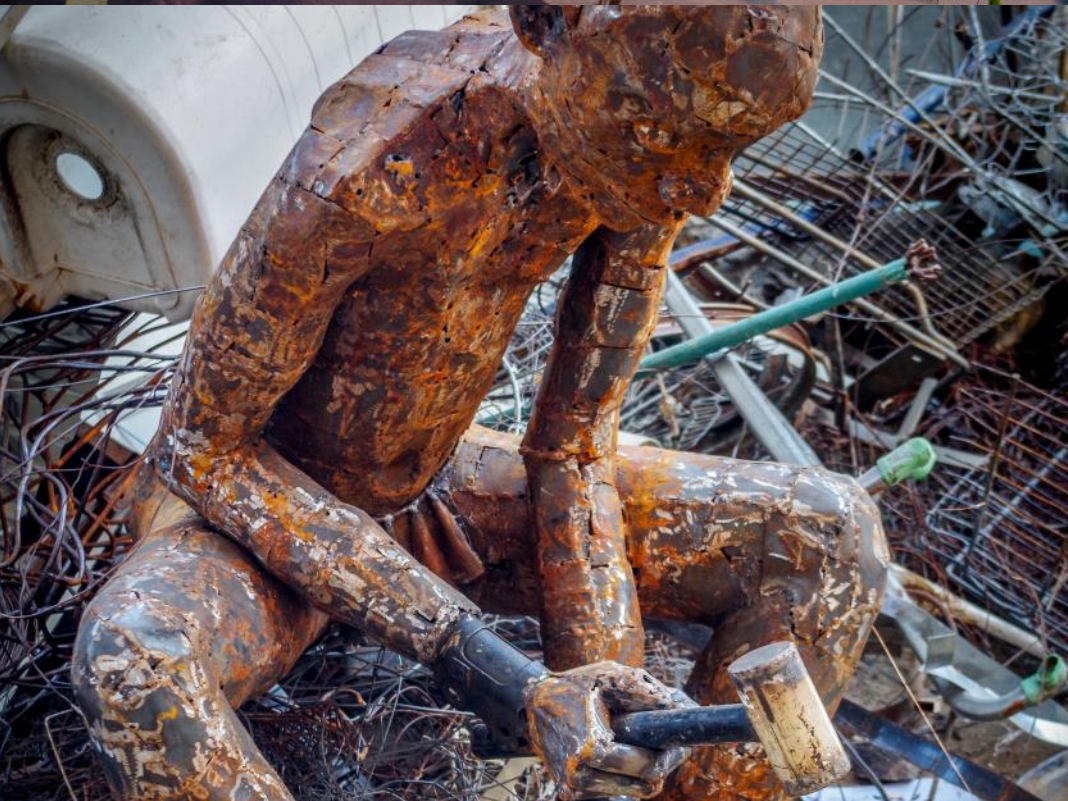

## Windhoek Redefined Art Tour

This tour focusses on topics such as contemporary Namibian art history and visual art trends, local socio-political-economic factors, and the role visual arts plays in Namibian society. Guests will come into direct contact with artists, be it in the most basic studios and homes in the townships of Windhoek or the more sophisticated local galleries. Guests will encounter artists of different disciplines, each employing materials in highly distinctive and creative ways, and they will be offered first-hand opportunities to experience artists' studio activities.



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## Marine Kayaking Excursion

Depart from Walvis Bay for a memorable kayaking adventure. Kayaking is an ideal way of seeing cape fur seals, Heaviside's and bottlenose dolphins, pelicans, flamingos and a wide variety of other sea birds. You do not require prior experience or fitness to enjoy this leisurely paddle. If you are lucky, there is also a chance of seeing whales, leatherback turtles and sunfish.



## Marine Catamaran Excursion

Depart from the Walvis Bay Waterfront for a marine educational sightseeing tour in the bay area in search of the Marine Big Five: Whales, Dolphins, Mola, Leatherback turtle and seals. Your journey from Pelican Point takes you past some of the more interesting ships and oil rigs in the bay as you are served fresh oysters with sparkling wine, savoury snacks and desserts.



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## Sandwich Harbour Tour

Beautiful dunes have to be crossed to get to Sandwich Harbour. If weather and tides allow, you get a chance to visit the Sandwich Harbour Lagoon, one of Southern Africa's richest and unique wetlands. Wedged between the sea and the Namib Dunes, potable water seeping from the underground aquifer sustains the freshwater vegetation at the base of the dunes. Stop on top of a high dune overlooking the Atlantic Ocean for a light lunch including a selection of snacks, salad, bread, and fresh fruit with sparkling wine, oysters, and drinks.





## Swakopmund Old City Tour

You will be taken through the city of Swakopmund via transfer vehicle. The main focus being on history and old architecture from the German Colonial era. Should time allow it, a short stop can be made at the Swakopmund Pier for you to walk or a museum visit.



## Swakopmund Boat Cruise

An all-in-one three hours 30 minutes cruise where you truly get to experience all the bay has to offer. Get ready to learn about Namibia's marine life while enjoying delicious food and refreshing beverages on deck.



## Quad Biking

The ultimate experience right in the heart of the beautiful Namib Desert. Ride through some of the highest sand dunes in the world with your own quad bike while following a guide. Traverse through the endless maze of dunes and let the adrenaline flow.





## Welwitschia Tour

An enlightening journey take you through the ancient canyons of the Moon Valley, one of the most fascinating areas of the Namib Desert. Discover the medicinal and nutritional use of desert adapted flora, and delve into the secrets of the Welwitschia mirabilis. Learn about its intrinsic value to the indigenous people who once roamed Southern Africa. This spectacular area is also home to some wildlife, and one might just spot springbok, ostrich, klipspringer, Swallow-tailed Bee-eater, Karoo Chat and others.



## Swakopmund City Tour

Take a journey through time. Learn about Swakopmund's colourful history, its origins and its well maintained buildings from the colonial era. Venture into modern day Swakopmund to find out just what Swakopmund is to the local people from all groups of society. Drive along luxury beachfront homes and travel into the townships. At the end of the tour, take a glance into the new areas and how this city is developing. Swakopmund yesterday, today and tomorrow.



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## Dolphin & Seal Cruises

The boat departs from Walvis Bay Waterfront and cruises past the oyster farms and fishing trawlers in the bay, towards the seal colony at Pelican Point. The cruise returns via Bird Island. A variety of birds such as pelicans, flamingos, cormorants and many more can be seen. Enjoy the antics of feeding the seals and pelicans on board. You will more than likely catch a glimpse of playful dolphins as well as a possible whale or sunfish. Fresh oysters, sparkling wine and snacks are served before returning to the harbour around midday.





## Sandboarding

Stand-up and Lie-Down sand boarding have grown in popularity over the years. Despite the fact that there are no ski-lifts in the dunes, sandboarding is great fun for everyone where speeds of up to eight kilometres an hour can be reached. There are two options to choose from, the traditional lie-down boarding is the easy option, or test your balancing skills with the stand-up boarding which uses snowboards.



## Tandem Skydiving

Enjoy a 30-minute scenic flight, and when the plane reaches 10 000 feet, you experience a 30-35 seconds free-fall at 220 kilometre an hour before the parachute is deployed. Another five to eight-minute glide follows whilst descending to a tiptoe landing at your original departure point.

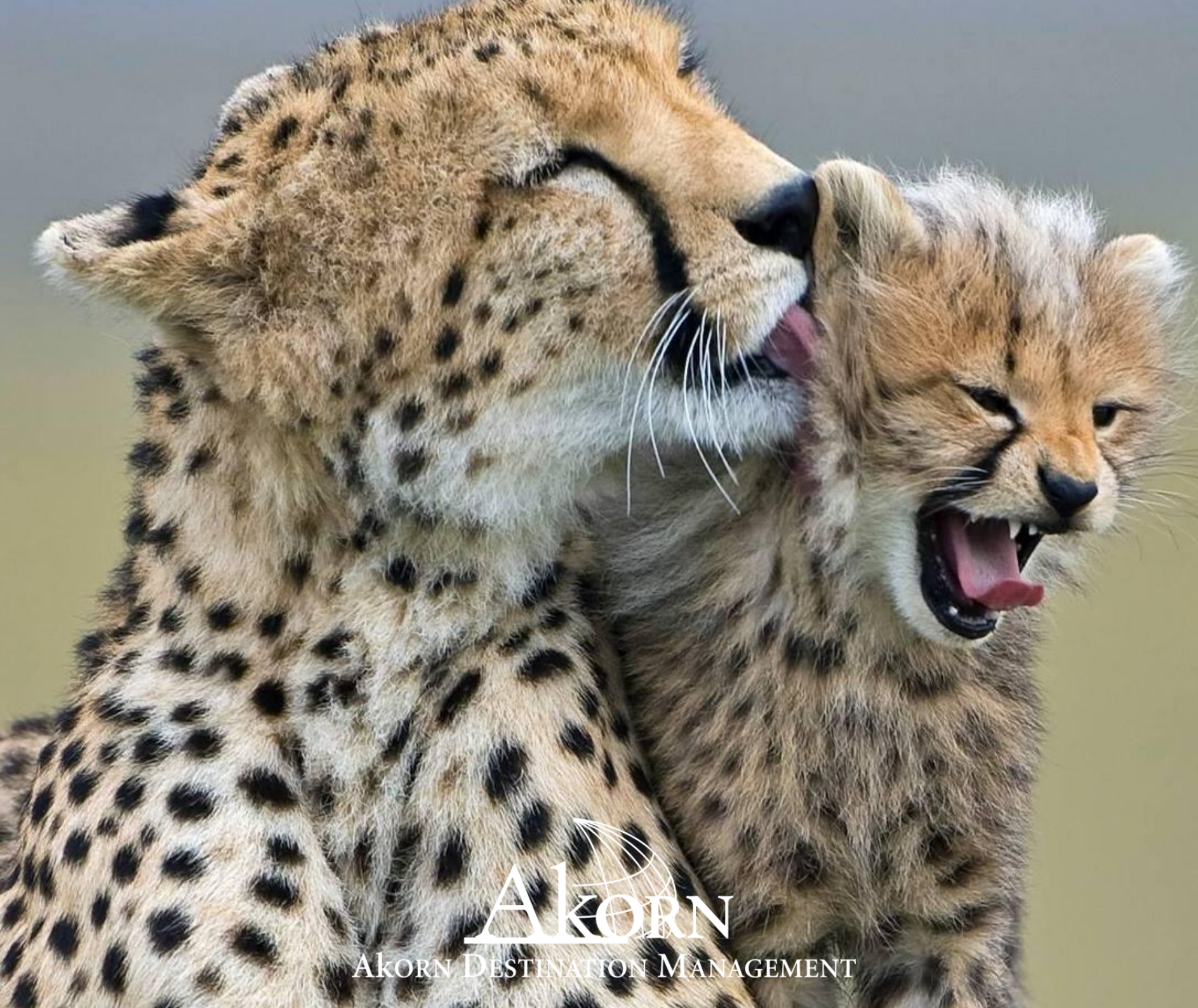


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## Fat bike Tours

Feel the fresh coastal air, take in the silence and breath-taking scenery of the oldest desert in the world while enjoying the thrill of cycling up and down Namibia's famous dunes. Guaranteed to excite and offer an unforgettable and unique cycling experience.





## Cheetah Conservation Fund

CCF is a non-profit organisation founded in 1990 and its primary goal is saving the cheetah from extinction. It has developed a set of integrated programmes that work together to save the cheetah and its ecosystem. CCF's Visitor's Centre offers a range of captivating and educational activities and tours for overnight guests and day visitors to experience cheetahs up-close and to learn about conservation.



## Hot Air Ballooning

After a spectacular launch and take-off as the sun rises over the world's oldest desert, your flight (depending on the wind) takes you over arid landscapes with views of the vast sand-sea, gravel plains and breath-taking mountain scenery. After soaring over the desert, a delicious continental brunch awaits, complete with sparkling wine.



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## Living Desert Tour

The journey begins in Swakopmund and explores the local dune belt between Walvis Bay and Swakopmund, which is about 30 kilometres long, five kilometres wide and supports an impressive wealth of fauna and flora. Great care is taken in sharing knowledge with you on each desert animal, including emphasis on special desert-adaptations and nature's perfect design used for survival in the desert.





## Shipwreck Sandwich Harbour Excursion

This one-day excursion will take you past Sandwich Harbour further South along the rugged coastline. Departing from Walvis Bay Waterfront , the tour heads past the Lagoon to see masses of flamingos, through the exclusive Concession area to the Kuiseb river delta. If weather and tides allow, the drive continues to the Sandwich Harbour Lagoon along the beach, one of Southern Africa's richest and unique wetlands in Namibia. Lunch will be served with a selection of fresh oysters, meat, fish platters, sparkling wine, beer and cooldrinks. The route homewards heads over some exhilarating dunes as well as displaying some of the area's typical fauna and flora.





## Scenic Flight Round-Trip Swakopmund

This round trip departs from Swakopmund and flies over the Namib Desert, abandoned Diamond Camps, two shipwrecks and then loops back up to Sandwich Harbour, Walvis Bay, the Salt Pans and then back to Swakopmund.





## Extended Scenic Round-Trip Swakopmund

You take off from Swakopmund Airstrip and fly over the Namib Sea Sand dune landscape, over the Bird Sanctuary, past the Lagoon and salt fields, through the Kuiseb River Basin where there is a chance to spot animal life, alongside the coast until you reach the famous Sandwich Harbour. Turn around for the flight back to Swakopmund Airstrip along the coast, past Walvis Bay.



  
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## Kolmanskop Ghost Town

A true photographer's dream, Kolmanskop Ghost Town is one of Namibia's most interesting attractions! Travel back in time into probably one of the best preserved desert ghost towns in Africa. The tour provides information about the day to day life of the diamond village inhabitants and mine workers. Stroll around to inspect the deserted buildings with many engulfed in desert sand.



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### Kayaking at Bird Rock

Paddle in calm waters, enjoy wonderful bird life, see seals playing and dolphins swimming. Pelicans, cormorants and flamingos are amongst the many birds to be seen on the beach, water and in the air. Bird Rock is a historic location at the central coast and your guide will share lots of interesting historical information. After kayaking, recharge with a cup of hot coffee or tea or hot chocolate before packing up and heading back to Swakopmund.
